### **Safety and Security Zone for Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Ship Transit Sabine Pass, Texas**

#### **TRINITY ARROW**

The Captain of the Port, Port Arthur, Texas will institute a Safety and Security Zone for the Sabine Bank Channel and the Sabine-Neches Waterway near Sabine Pass, Texas, for the inbound transit of the LNG ship TRINITY ARROW. The Safety and Security zone will be in effect for an approximately four hour period between the hours of 12:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 24, 2008.

The northern boundary of the Safety and Security Zone is south of Mesquite Point on the Sabine-Neches Waterway. The southern boundary of the Safety and Security Zone is beyond the southern end of the Sabine Jetties at Lighted Buoy 33 and Lighted Bell Buoy 34 on the Sabine Bank Channel.

U. S. Coast Guard, Jefferson County Sheriff, Cameron Parish Sheriff, and other cooperating agency patrol boats will enforce the conditions of the Safety and Security Zone. Vessel Traffic Service Port Arthur will coordinate commercial traffic and keep mariners informed of the actual times and the current status of the Safety and Security Zone.
