SET HURRICANE CONDITION WHISKEY

Effective at 12:00 CDT, July 23, 2010, the U.S. Coast Guard Captain of the Port, Port Arthur has set **Port Condition WHISKEY** and established a temporary safety zone for the port(s) of Beaumont, TX, Port Arthur, TX, Orange, TX and Lake Charles, LA including all tributaries and connecting waterways. Gale force winds from Tropical Storm BONNIE are expected to make landfall along the coast of southeast Texas and western Louisiana **within 72 hours**. The following restrictions apply:

1. All cargo transfer operations must be completed before sustained winds reach 35 MPH.
2. All commercial vessels greater than 500 gross tons and seagoing tugs and barges greater than 200 gross tons intending to remain in port must immediately notify the Captain of the Port of their intentions and submit a Remaining In Port Checklist to the Captain of the Port.
3. Vessels bound for these ports which are unable to depart prior to the closing of the port are advised to seek an alternate destination.

To ensure the safety of your vessels and crews, now is the time to plan. Vessels are advised to seek safe harbor in the northern reaches of the waterway. Survey places to moor or anchor to safely ride out a tropical storm or hurricane, and make available the necessary heavy weather mooring gear. **Vessels shall not moor in locations that impede the safe transit of vessels in the channel.** By regulation, vessels intending to moor at 33 CFR 105 facilities must have an agreed upon security arrangement with the facility prior to the vessels mooring.
