**REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON COAST DRAFT LNG POLICY**

The Coast Guard has announced the availability of two draft policy letters for public comment. The first draft policy letter provides guidance for liquefied natural gas (LNG) fuel transfer operations and training of personnel on vessels using natural gas as fuel in U.S. waters. The second draft policy letter discusses guidance and existing regulations applicable to vessels and waterfront facilities intending to conduct LNG marine fuel transfer operations.
