### **KCS Railroad Bridge Closure Neches River (Mile 19.5) Beaumont, TX**

The KCS vertical lift railroad bridge at mile 19.5 on the Neches River will be closed for maintenance in the down position and inoperable for marine traffic from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. on Thursday, July 11, 2013. Vertical clearance in the down position is 13 feet.

Facilities up-river from the bridge closure that may be affected include Chicago Bridge and Iron Company, Bo-Mac Contractors, APAC-Beaumont, and the Beaumont Yacht Club.

Affected vessels and facilities should plan accordingly. Up-to-date information will be available from the Vessel Traffic Service (VTS) Port Arthur at 409-719-5070 or on VHF channels 65A or 13.
