

General description of AOR: Station Charlevoix's AOR is encompassed by a line from shoreline of eastern Lake Michigan at 45-01.0' N to 45-22.5' N, 086-19.0' W to 45-41.0' N, 086-06.0' W to 45-50.0' N, 085-43.0' W to 45-38.0' N, 085-04.0' W thence southerly along the shoreline to the point of origin including Grand Traverse Bay.
