General description of AOR:

Station Kenosha's Area of Responsibility (AOR) is encompassed by a line from the shoreline of western Lake Michigan at 42°20.0'N and runs northeasterly to 42°27.5'N, 087°00.0'W; thence due north to 42°53.0'N, 087°00.0'W, thence southwesterly to the shoreline at 42°49.0'N, thence southerly along the shoreline to the point of origin. Additionally, Station Kenosha is responsible for Auxiliary operations and limited law enforcement upon the Chain-O-Lakes, Illinois.
