General description of AOR: Unit boundaries and area of responsibility change with the operation status of AUXOP Green and Station (small) Washington Island.

WINTER: On the Lake Michigan side of Door county peninsula Station Sturgeon Bays southern boundary begins at 44° 29”N (just north of Kewaunee) and runs southeasterly to 44° 20”N, 087° W, thence northeasterly to 45° 41” N, 086° 06” W, thence northwesterly to Point Aux Barques (45° 45.5”N, 086° 22”W), thence southerly along the shoreline to the starting point including all Green Bay.

SUMMER: When Station (small) Washington Island is open it assumes the area north of the line from 45° 05.3” N, 086° 33” W, to Cana Island Light (45° 05.3” N, 087° 02.8” W) to Eagle Bluff Light (45° 10.1” N, 087° 14.2” W) to 45° 15.2” N, 087° 29.8” W.

When AUXOP Green Bay is open its area encompasses all navigable water on Green Bay south of a diagonal line between points 44° 55.7” N, 087° 46.9” W then southerly from 44° 33” N, 088° W. During the summer activation period the AUXOP has primary response status, but defaults to neighboring units (Station Sturgeon Bay) in adverse weather conditions.
