Directions from the nearest highway: The following directions are available with a map on the unit's CG Central website (map-quest, etc., are inaccurate);

FROM THE EAST: I-94 W into Indiana / Exit onto off-ramp at exit 40B to US-20 W (US-35 N) / Continue onto US-20 W (US-35 N) / Continue onto US-35 (Michigan Blvd) / Bear left onto US-12 (Michigan Blvd) / Turn right onto Kenefic Dr (Pine Dr) toward Washington Park / Bear right onto Franklin Street and cross the drawbridge / Turn right at the monument and get into the left lane / Make a U-Turn and follow the road past the monument and past memorial circle to the Coast Guard Station

FROM THE WEST: I-94 E into Indiana/Bear right onto off-ramp at exit 34B to US-421 / Bear right onto US-421 / Continue onto US-421 as it turns into Franklin St. / Turn right onto 11th St. / Turn left onto Pine St. and follow as it crosses US-12 / Bear right onto Franklin Street and cross the drawbridge / Turn right at the monument and get into the left lane / Make a U-Turn and follow the road past the monument and past memorial circle to the Coast Guard Station
