Subj: 2012 COAST GUARD FESTIVAL SPORTS EVENTS

1. PURPOSE. This Notice publishes the schedule of sports events planned for the 2012 Coast Guard Festival in Grand Haven, Michigan. Coast Guard units, as well as individual members, are invited to participate. Entry blanks are attached and should be reproduced locally. Note that all checks, with the exception of the Bicycle Tour, should be made payable to the Grand Haven Coast Guard Festival, Inc.
2. ACTION. This Notice shall be given the widest dissemination possible within the Ninth District. SFO Grand Haven will also distribute this Notice to all INCONUS District Public Affairs Offices and all Headquarters units. All Coast Guard units and personnel are highly encouraged to take advantage of this unique and fun opportunity. Participants should get their applications in as soon as possible to ensure inclusion in each event. Participants may go to www.coastguardfest.org or www.grandhaven.com for lodging information in the Grand Haven area.
3. DISCUSSION. Particulars on each event, including dates and contact person, are described below:
 - a. Coast Guard 5K & 10K Road Race: This event is open to the public. The 5K race begins Saturday, 28 July 2012 at 0730 at the Tri-Cities YMCA. The 10K race begins at 0830. There will also be a 1-mile fun run starting at 0845 and a Tot Trot Obstacle Course at 0915. There is no entry fee for Coast Guard personnel.  - b. Coast Guard Festival Bike Tour: This event is open to the public. All tours begin and end at Grand Haven's Harbor Island and include a post-ride celebration. On Sunday, 29 July 2012, the 100-mile event starts at 0800, 60-mile event starts at 0930,

and the 30-mile event starts at 1000. Aid stations and professional sag wagon provided. There will be a bike shop on-site at start for essentials. Brochures, registration forms, and route maps are at www.loosespokes.com (click on Events). Same-day registration available.

- c. Coast Guard Golf Tournament: This year's event is open to all Coast Guard Active Duty, Retired, Reserve, Auxiliary personnel and civilian employees. This year's event will return to Grand Haven Golf Club at 17000 Lincoln Street, Grand Haven, Michigan 49417, (616) 842-4040. The traditional four (4) person 18 hole scramble is \$30 to play and early registration is encouraged. The tournament will be held on Tuesday, 31 July 2012, beginning with registration at 0730 and shotgun start at 0800 EDT. The cost of the tournament includes 18 holes of golf, refreshments and prizes, concluding with a lunch and awards ceremony. Please indicate the names of the team members you want to play with or you will be paired according to registrations.
 - d. Coast Guard Softball Tournament: Rosters shall be comprised of Active Duty or Retired personnel, drilling Reservists, and no more than two Coast Guard civilian employees. The tournament will be played Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, 01 August – 03 August 2012. A mandatory Team Managers' meeting will be held Tuesday evening, 31 July 2012 at 1900 at SFO Grand Haven to discuss tournament rules and team schedules. Entry fee is \$100.00 per team. **The entry deadline is 23 July**. Mr. Dave Eagin is the coordinator and may be reached at (616) 846-5940 or DLEagin@charter.net.
