




# DEEPWATER

Mr. Shea is the Regional Desk Manager for Western Pacific and Indian Ocean nations that are in the PACOM Area of Responsibility (AOR). He has oversight responsibilities for all U.S.C.G. Deepwater Program International Security Assistance (SA) and Foreign Military Sales (FMS) activities in the PACOM AOR. In addition, Mr. Shea coordinates all relevant events that involve the Deepwater Program as they pertain to cooperative initiatives in the region. The Deepwater Program is the largest acquisition program in the history of the Coast Guard. This innovative acquisition program will develop, acquire, and sustain an affordable integrated system of surface, air, command and control, and logistics assets that serve America's maritime and security requirements.



Mr. Shea has been involved with U.S. Government international security cooperation programs for 20 years. He is very knowledgeable of FMS, Armaments Cooperative Projects (ACP) and Direct Commercial Contracts (DCC) procedures. He completed two three-year tours at the Navy International Programs Office in Washington, DC and one three-year tour on the J4 Staff at Pacific Command Headquarters, Camp Smith, Hawaii. He retired at the rank of Commander, USN.

During the past 10 years, Mr. Shea has been directing contractor management services for Navy international programs to include aircraft, missiles, undersea weapons, ships, and communications systems. He also was instrumental in designing the Deepwater Program international plan.
