CDRs,

I have had many conversations with different POCs today, and I want to ensure that this information got pushed to the right people.

1. We have initiated CISM intervention counseling for all crews (both MSSTs and Sta Seattle).
2. The boat involved, CG 25501 has been pulled and trailered back to ISC Seattle. We have towed it inside of Building 7, where it is currently secured in a cage in my engineering spaces.
3. PO Gill's PPE & TAC Gear is currently secured in my team's kennel spaces here in building 7. I took custody of it from Station Seattle. They have it packed into a 32 g garbage can. It is soaking wet and a biohazard. We will transfer the contents into paper bags tomorrow, which will allow it to dry out w/o mold & mildew forming.
4. A load-planner from MSST Anchorage will be arriving here tomorrow. We will coordinate with him and provide all necessary support to assist them with their demob. -- Unless directed otherwise, we will plan on sending the 25501 back with the other boats on Saturday. As such, we will need to defuel and prep it for the flight and deliver it to McChord for certification later this week, so I respectfully request notification soonest if the IO or MISHAP Board will need the boat to be available here beyond Tues/Weds time frame.

I talked w/ [redacted]; he plans on traveling to Seattle tomorrow, and [redacted] may as well. I've offered Steve any support needed to help facilitate their arrival.
