To Whom It May Concern,

The following is a timeline correlating my memories of the events of 17 August with a series of photographs that I took on my camera. My best estimate of the timestamp on my camera is that camera times are approximately 3 hours, 5 minutes ahead of actual times. I.e. a photo that is timestamped 1805 was really taken at 1500.

I awoke a few minutes before 1700 on the 17th, showered and headed out to Ice Liberty, which was ongoing. Key photos in my sequence are as follows:

I watched for a few more moments, I believe 5 minutes but perhaps as much as 10, and returned the short distance over to the dive area. At this time the divers were being pulled in.
