I have received CPR training about two years ago at my previous unit which was NESU Seattle.

On the day of the accident I was on the ice witnessing the the rescue efforts that were being conducted on LT. Hill. Moments later I was called over from an other shipmate to help assist BM2 Duque out of the water on to the ice. I remember helping getting his equipment of. There was a white foamy liquid, mixed with blood purging from his mouth and nose. He was also biting on his tongue so I then opened his jaw to clear his airway. I yelled for help at that point and more people came over. I was told not to breath down his mouth because of the liquid that was purging out of him. I rolled him on his side to help drain the fluids. Moments later the stokes litter arrived and we got BM2 inside of it and transported him on the foot of the ships brow. I consumed two beers and two sodas that day on Ice Liberty.
