Cutter History:

Formerly *Mills*, *Hamlin* was purchased by the Boston customs collector for \$15,500. On 11 January 1867 her name was changed to *Hannibal Hamlin*. She was a harbor vessel in Boston for her service life and sold for \$321 on 28 August 1899.
