He began his career in the Coast Guard when he enlisted in June 1997 and graduated from Basic Training (India 151) in August 1997. He attained the rank of Petty Officer First Class (E6) prior to attending Officer Candidate School in New London, CT. LT Himsey graduated from OCS in February 2007 (OCS Class 1-07). He currently serves as the Honor Guard Company Commander of the Ceremonial Honor Guard in Washington, DC.
