



Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Supplemental Student Loan

CGMA will loan eligible clients up to \$700 if a demonstrated financial need remains after receiving the maximum assistance authorized under the Coast Guard Tuition Assistance (CGTA) Program. (*See COMDTINST 1500.24 (series) or contact your Education Services Officer for details concerning the CGTA Program.*)

The loan amount cannot exceed the difference between the total amount the client paid and the amount of CGTA received. A new Supplemental Student Loan will not be provided until all previous such loans have been repaid.

Eligibility:

Any CGMA client who is eligible to participate in the CGTA Program (Active Duty, Selected Reserve or Civilian employee) may be eligible for this need-based loan.

Eligibility does not extend to CGMA members who are currently delinquent in repaying any CGMA loan or who appear on the CGMA Restricted List.

To apply:

Complete the CGMA Application for Assistance, CGMA Form 5 and the CGMA Budget Form, CGMA Form 15. Indicate "Supplemental Student Loan Program" in Section C of the Form 5.

Submit the following documents **to your nearest CGMA representative:**

- CGMA Form 5
- CGMA Form 15
- A copy of the signed Tuition Assistance Authorization, CGI Form 1560 issued by the CG Institute

If mailing or faxing your application, provide a legible copy (front and back) of client's valid ID Card.

The application must be submitted no later than 30 days after the course begins.
