Ms. Sheridan has over 30 years of experience in accounting and financial management and has been a member of the Senior Executive Service (SES) since 2005. Prior to joining the Coast Guard, Ms. Sheridan worked for the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) as Deputy Chief Financial Officer (CFO) and Chief Budget Officer. Ms. Sheridan served as manager and integrator for all levels of the FHWA management on budget and financial issues. She planned, administered, and coordinated the FHWA program and program planning related to the budget process. This included the availability of appropriations and allocations of Federal-aid and other highway program funds, audit issues, financial management initiatives, and any matter potentially

impacting the financial resources of the Agency.

Prior to her SES appointment, she served as a Senior Government Consultant for Optimum Management Systems, LLC to the FHWA's CFO, where she analyzed and reconciled the FHWA's budgetary and financial records in the preparation of auditable financial statements. Prior to that, she served as the Director, Financial Management Division for the National Aeronautical and Space Administration, where she was responsible for the development, implementation and execution of an agency-wide multi-year strategic financial management improvement plan. She also served as the Director of Financial Reporting Directorate at the Headquarters Department of the Army where she provided financial and organizational leadership expertise in implementing various financial legislation.

Ms. Sheridan has held other civilian and military positions of leadership in the Department of the Army and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. She retired at the rank of Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserve following 31 years of active and reserve assignments. She holds a Bachelor of Applied Science Degree in Resource Management from Troy University, a Master of Business Administration Degree from Syracuse University, and a Master of Science Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University.

She has received numerous performance and honor awards including a 2001 "Best Practice in Government Award" from the Association of Government Accountants.
