Rated: PG-13 for intense sequences of violence and some menace
Genre: Action/Thriller **Runtime: 104 MIN**
Synopsis: The Dark knight reunites Christopher Nolan with star Christian Bale, who returns to continue Batman's war on crime

TUESDAY: The Mummy:
Cast: Brendan Fraser, Jet Li, Maria Bello, John Hannah
Rated: PG13 for adventure action and violence
Genre: Adventure **Runtime: 112 MIN**
Synopsis: Brendan Fraser returns as swashbuckling adventurer Rick O'Connell to face off against Jet Li as ancient China's supernatural Han Emperor in a story that leads them from the forbidden tombs of China high into the frigid Himalayas

WEDNESDAY: Step Brothers:
Cast: Will Ferrell, John C. Reilly, Richard Jenkins, Mary Steenburgen
Rated: R for crude and sexual content, and pervasive language
Genre: Comedy **Runtime: 98 MIN**
Synopsis: In Step Brothers, Ferrell plays Brennan huff, a sporadically employed thirty-nine year old that lives with his mother, Nancy (Mary Steenburgen). John C. Reilly plays Dale Doback, a terminally unemployed forty-year old who lives with his father, Robert (Richard Jenkins). THURSDAY: Swing Vote:
Cast: Kevin Costner, Dennis Hopper, Nathan Lane, Kelsey Grammer
Rated: PG-13 for Language
Genre: Comedy/Drama **Runtime: 120 MIN**
Synopsis: Swing Vote follows the story of Bud Johnson (Kevin Costner), an apathetic, beer slinging, lovable loser, who is coasting through a life that has passed him by. The one bright spot is his precocious, over achieving twelve year old daughter Molly. She takes care of both of them, until one mischievous moment on Election Day, when she accidentally sets off a chain of events which culminates in the election coming down to one vote...her dad's. Suddenly, Bud Johnson, the nobody, becomes the voice for everybody when the world realizes that his vote will be the one that elects the next president. Politicians invade the small town of Texico, New Mexico and it's unwitting inhabitants, waging war for Bud's vote

Genre: Science Fiction/Fantasy and Animation **Runtime: 100 MIN**
Synopsis: On the front lines of an intergalactic struggle between good and evil, fans young and old will join such favorite characters as Anakin Skywalker, Obi-Wan Kenobi and Padme' Amidala. Stakes are high, and the fate of the Star Wars universe rests in the hands of the daring Jedi Knights. Their exploits lead to the action-packed battles and astonishing new revelations
