Preparing for Travel and Stay at TRACEN Petaluma

Location

TRACEN Petaluma is located in southern Sonoma County, California, only 50 minutes northwest of San Francisco. In less than an hour, you can be in the cultural heart of San Francisco, the world-renowned vineyards of Sonoma and Napa Counties, the breathtaking beaches of the Pacific coast, or walking among the giant redwoods.

Tips for Travel and Packing

Here are some tips on how to plan for your stay at Training Center Petaluma:

- **Make all transportation arrangements early.** Plan on delays into and out of San Francisco International Airport (SFO). Remember, you'll need \$30.00 to take the Sonoma County Airport Express Shuttle that will take you from SFO to Petaluma.
 - **We recommend making travel plans for Saturday, to adequately have the time to relax, settle in and prepare for Monday Petty Officer Indoctrination Program.**
 - **Bring sufficient and required uniform items** to meet the requirements of the school you are attending. A full sea bag is required to "A" School students.
 - **Bring sufficient cash** or other monetary support.
 - **Bring a light jacket or sweater.** Even our summer evenings are usually rather cool.
 - **Students are encouraged to bring their own sporting equipment,** especially those staying for a long period of time, for activities such as biking, softball, baseball, tennis, skateboarding, etc. But note, space is somewhat limited in the barracks.
 - **Students are allowed to have personal phones and TVs in their rooms.** However, you must bring these items with you or purchase them here.
 - **Towels are not provided in the barracks.** Students must bring or purchase their own.
 - **You may bring your own bed linens** (if you choose).
 - **Pack judiciously.** Storage space in the barracks is limited.
 - Due to limited storage, students are **STRONGLY discouraged from bringing weapons, ammunition, or gunpowder on board.** All weapons, ammunition, and gunpowder **MUST** be registered and stored at the Police Department. Please coordinate with the police before proceeding onto the Training Center.
 - **If you encounter any trouble enroute, call the Training Center Police Department at (707) 765-7215 and explain your situation.**

Student Rules and Guidelines While Onboard the TRACEN

Keep these general student rules and guidelines in mind during your stay at Petaluma. For further information on student rules refer to the base and barracks regulations provided by the MAA staff and School Chiefs.

- **Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the barracks or POVs** (Horsley Hall, Mace Hall, Bldg 124, Steadman Hall or Harrison Hall).
- **Civilian visitors** are only allowed during visiting hours in the front waiting and recreation areas of Horsley Hall. Visitors must be sponsored by a member of the barracks and sign in and out with the MAA/DMAA at the front desk. Visiting hours are Sunday through Thursday from the time liberty is granted to 2200, and Friday and Saturday from the time liberty is granted to 2400. Civilians are not allowed anywhere in the barracks rooms of Horsley Hall or in any other barracks buildings.
- Visits by members of the opposite sex in the barrack rooms are not allowed under any circumstances. **No intimate contact or sexual relations are allowed in the barracks at any time.**
- **Driving while over the legal blood alcohol limit or drinking underage** incurs very serious consequences including expulsion from school.
- **Fraternization between “A” and “C” School students is not allowed.** Likewise, “A” and “C” School students may not fraternize with disenrolled students.
- **In case of medical or other emergency while on base, dial 911.**
- **Carry an extra copy of your orders.** Until students receive rations-in-kind cards, they must present a copy of their orders to the cashier at the Galley (Haley Hall). **Note:** The copy presented to the cashier should show the time and date you reported.
- **Park in designated student parking areas only!** Please see the designated student parking area map provided upon arrival for authorized parking areas.

Getting to the Training Center

Arriving by Plane

San Francisco International Airport (SFO) is the primary airport. SFO offers direct ground transportation to Petaluma. The USO lounge is open 24 hours and is located in the South Terminal.

- **Oakland International Airport (OAK)** also offers direct ground transportation to Petaluma. The USO lounge is on the second floor of Terminal 1 and open 0900-1700, Monday through Friday.
- **Santa Rosa Airport** has scheduled airline service, but because ground transportation, other than taxi, is not available, it is **NOT recommended** as a gateway to Petaluma.

Transportation from Airports

The recommended travel from SFO (or OAK) is the Sonoma County Airport Express, a commercial shuttle, which provides direct services from San Francisco International Airport and Oakland International Airport to Petaluma seven days a week. Reservations are not required. From the Petaluma drop-off, it is a 10 minute liberty van (or taxi ride) to the base. Hours of operation are **0500-2300**. <p>Domestic Flights: Buses pick up passengers on the lower level (outside the baggage claim area) on the center island.</p> <p>International Flights: Pick up is located at the Arrivals Level outside customs and baggage claim in the outer roadway center island (“Scheduled Buses” zone).</p>	<p>All Flights: Buses pick up and disembark passengers directly outside baggage claim at the Regional Transportation stop. The location is across two lanes of traffic, between the terminals and the rental car offices. The last trip is at 2100.</p>

Cost is \$30 for a one-way ticket (ask for the military rate). **Note:** This is the military discount price. Military prices must be requested and verification, with military ID, is required. The cost is reimbursable when you complete your travel claim.

Drop-off point in Petaluma is the **Petaluma Fairgrounds terminal**. After arriving in Petaluma, take a taxi or wait momentarily for the liberty van to the Training Center (**review attached liberty van schedule on the following page**). If it is late, you may want to grab a bite to eat (restaurants located nearby) before arriving at the base.

Getting to the Training Center, *Continued*

Getting from Petaluma to the Training Center

Taxi: Once you have arrived in Petaluma, the ride is approximately 20 minutes, and costs approximately \$30. The cost of the taxi is reimbursable, so keep your receipt. Take the taxi directly to Horsley Hall.

Training Center Liberty Van provides transportation between the Training Center and various points in Petaluma. This service is for students during their stay at Training Center Petaluma (after checking-in and prior to departure), but may be used by arriving students on a space available basis only. Due to capacity limitations, personnel traveling under orders should be prepared to take commercial transportation. These policies are not affected by the pay grade of the rider. Dependents are not authorized to ride the liberty van.

Training Center Liberty Van

Hours of Operation: The Training Center Liberty Van operates during the following hours:

Days of Week	Hours of Operation
Monday through Thursday	1700-2300 (<i>on the odd hours</i>)
Friday	1700- 0200*
Saturday	0900-1700 (odd hours), 1800-0200*
Sunday (& holidays)	0900-2300 (<i>on the odd hours</i>)

*The 0100 and 0200 runs on Friday and Saturday stop only at the Bus Stop at Petaluma Blvd and E. Washington St. and then return to Horsley Hall.

Getting to the Training Center, Continued

Training Center Liberty Van, Continued

Pick Up Times: The Training Center Liberty Van picks up passengers at the following locations on the odd hour during scheduled times of operation. Times are approximate and you should allow for slight adjustments:

Location	Time of Arrival*
Horsley Hall	On the hour
Training Center Theater	5 minutes past the hour
Pacific Theater in Rohnert Park	30 minutes past the hour
Walmart Shopping Center in Rohnert Park	40 minutes past the hour
Bus Stop at Petaluma Blvd. and E. Washington St.	55 minutes past the hour
Petaluma Fairgrounds (Airport Express)	10 minutes past the hour

*The above times are approximate. Drivers, upon their arrival at designated stops, shall wait at least two (2) minutes at each stop. In cases where the vehicle is full of riders, the driver shall continue on the designated route to notify any waiting passengers that they are loaded to capacity and inform them of the next van arrival time.

DEPENDENTS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO RIDE THE LIBERTY VAN

Arriving by Personal Vehicle or Rental Car

Upon arrival at Training Center Petaluma you **must** have the following items in your vehicle or in your possession at **all** times:

- **Valid Proof of Auto Insurance.** You are required to have liability coverage on your vehicle. If you do not have proof of insurance in your possession or do not have insurance you will not be allowed to drive your vehicle onto the base. You will be required to park your vehicle next to the Pass and ID building until you can show proof of insurance.
- **Vehicle Registration.** The vehicle does not need to be registered in your name, but your name must appear on the insurance policy. You will need a copy of the Rental Car agreement.
- **Military ID**
- **Driver's License**

Getting to the Training Center, *Continued*

Arriving By Personal Vehicle or Rental Car, *Continued*

If you are driving a motorcycle to Training Center Petaluma, the following is **required** to operate the motorcycle on base.

- Proof of completion of a certified State or National Motorcycle Safety Course
- Valid State driver’s license with motorcycle endorsement
- Headlight on while driving
- Motorcycle shall be equipped with rear-view mirrors
- Driver and passenger must wear a DOT approved helmet properly fastened under the chin
- Properly worn impact or shatter resistant eye protective device
- Glasses, goggles, or a full face shield attached to the helmet – *Windshield or fairings are NOT adequate eye protection.*

Motorcycle drivers and passengers are **strongly encouraged** to wear the following:

- Leather footwear with over-the-ankle coverage
- Leather, full-fingered gloves, trousers, and long-sleeved shirt or jacket
- High visibility (retro-reflective) outer garments

Directions to the Training Center

1	Take Highway 101 (from north or south) to Petaluma. Petaluma is approximately 30 miles North of San Francisco. Take the East Washington Street exit.
2	Head west on East Washington Street about 10 miles to Tomales Road. Note: East Washington Street becomes Bodega Avenue after it passes through Petaluma. A sign is posted at the intersection of Bodega Avenue and Tomales Road with the words “Coast Guard Training Center” and an arrow indicating the correct direction.
3	Turn left on to Tomales Road. Proceed about one mile to a flashing amber light. Turn left (at the light) into the Training Center entrance.
4	Report to the Training Center Pass and ID office to receive a temporary vehicle pass and for direction to Horsley Hall for barracks assignment.

Checking In & Quarters

Checking In

All “A” and “C” School Students must check in at Horsley Hall regardless of the hour they arrive. The MAA or DMAA staff at the front desk will hold your orders and issue you a room key.

It is recommended to travel on Saturday, to allow plenty of time on Sunday to prepare for Monday. If you do travel Sunday, you may not arrive till late on Sunday evening.

Coast Guard Uniform Regulations, including grooming standards, are strictly enforced at Training Center Petaluma. You may be in civilian attire when first checking in at TRACEN Petaluma, but you must have your orders in hand. You are expected to report for your first day of class in the uniform of the day, which is prescribed by each school.

The following organizational clothing is not allowed to be worn on the Training Center:

Student Barracks

“A” **School students** will be assigned to 3-6 person rooms in Horsley Hall, Steadman Hall, or Bldg. 124.

“C” **School students** may be assigned to 2-4 person rooms in various barracks depending on the course they are attending, their rank, and the availability of rooms.

Note: Students must bring towels, as they are not issued. You can bring you own bedding. For more information, call the Horsley Hall Quarterdeck.

Students, E-7 and above, will be assigned to 2-person rooms in the BOQ/CPOQ, Harrison Hall, if at all possible.

Washing machines and dryers are available free of charge in the barracks. Soap and bleach are not provided, but are available at the Mini-Mart. **Only powdered bleach is allowed in the barracks.**

Guest Housing

Temporary lodging is available for visitors, or for those awaiting housing.

Consolidated Club Guest Housing onboard TRACEN:

- Nine (9) rooms are available adjacent to the Consolidated Club. These rooms are extremely small and not recommended for long stays. They have private showers and are equipped with either bunk beds or queen-size beds. Room availability is extremely limited.
- The cost for guest housing ranges from \$35.00 to \$55.00.

Reservations for guest housing are accepted Monday through Friday from 0900-1800, and should be made one **month in advance**, except PCS personnel, reservations can be made 120 days ahead, through the Club Manager at (707) 765-7248. Attached personnel waiting for housing are given first priority, guests of attached personnel second, and all others on a first come, first served basis.

Checking In & Quarters, *Continued*

Guest Housing, **Novato Temporary Quarters** *Continued*

Novato is located approximately 25 miles south of the Training Center.

- Eight (8) motel style rooms with double bed, TV/VCR, refrigerator, private bath, and shared kitchen.
- Two suites with kitchenettes.
- Nine long-term two bedroom apartments, fully furnished, and operational.
- One three-bedroom duplex, fully furnished, etc.
- Costs depend on pay grade.

Dining

Exchange Services

The Training Center has numerous facilities available where food or every day items can be purchased. The following are the facilities and the products they sell:

- **Mini-Mart:** Similar to a convenience store, the mini-mart carries basic grocery items, beer, wine, liquor, and toiletries. Special orders on beverage items are accepted. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 0900-2100, and Saturday 1000-2100.

Exchange Services, Continued

- **Exchange:** The Exchange carries uniform clothing and accessories, housewares, electronics, music CDs and cassettes, greeting cards, jewelry, giftware, and clothing. Services include special orders, UPS shipping, film developing, flowers by wire, AT&T prepaid calling cards, and charge-to-pay sales of Small Stores Uniform items. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday 1000-1730, Saturday 1000-1630. The Exchange is closed on Sunday.
 - **Gas Station:** Unleaded and premium unleaded gas.

Athletic Facilities

Training Center Petaluma is a great place for exercise and has state-of-the-art equipment available to let you do just that. The following are the athletic facilities available:

- **Gymnasium:** This facility offers a weight training room with Cybex machines, free weights, treadmills, cross trainer, stair climber, versa climber and sauna. Basketball, tennis, racquetball, and volleyball courts are available. Hours are Monday through Thursday 0530-2200, Friday 0530-2100, Saturday and Sunday 0800-2000.
 - **Aquatic Sports Center:** The center includes an outdoor 25-meter pool. In addition, there is a wading pool and a spa for your enjoyment. Lockers and showers are also available. Lap swim is Monday through Friday, 0530-0700 and 1100-1300. Afternoon and evening swim hours vary throughout the year; however, every opportunity is made to have the pool open for your exercise and recreation enjoyment.

Recreation

The Morale, Well-Being, and Recreation (MWR) Customer Service Center, located at the “Hub” provides a variety of services and activities. MWR Office hours are 0900-1700 Monday through Friday. Hours may vary. The following are the services available:

- **Lake Recreation Area:** Available for picnicking and camping. Contact the Gymnasium attendant for camping reservations.
- **Recreational Rental Shop:** There is recreational equipment, bikes, camping equipment, etc., available for use or rent at the MWR Office.
- **Library:** Best sellers and old classics available for checkout. Extensive reference library and an area for children. Great place to study or just read for enjoyment. The library contains unit geographical files for most Coast Guard units. The library has a couple of computers for use also.

Services, Continued

Recreation, Continued

- **Rocks and Shoals Consolidated Club:** On base club facility available to all pay grades. Facilities include a sports bar, meeting room, movies, and games. A DJ is generally featured every Wednesday and Friday night. Party facilities are available for rent.
- **Two Rock Pizza** is co-located with the Consolidated Club. They offer a variety of menu items. On Saturday and Sunday fresh sandwiches, snack food, and microwave food are available also. The hours are Monday through Friday, 100-1300, 1730- 2200.
- **Movie Theater:** Open seven days a week, with first run movies shown throughout the month. Small snack bar available, selling popcorn and candy. Movies start at 1900. There is a matinee at 1400 on Saturday and Sunday.
- **Bowling Center:** Full service 6-lane bowling alley, adjacent to the Consolidated Club. Hours are Sunday through Thursday 1730-2200, and Friday and Saturday 1730-2300. Closed most holidays.
- **TRACEN Intramural Sports League:** The TRACEN supports an Intramural Sports League for students and permanent party members. Different sports are available throughout the year. Contact your Class Advisor or School Chief for more information.
- **Cyber Café:** MWR's Cyber Café is located on the first floor of Steadman Hall. The Café provides students Internet access for a small fee as well as an assortment of light food and drinks in a relaxing environment. Hours of operation are 0700-2200, Sunday through Saturday, with an attendant on duty 1700-1900.
- **Two Rock Coffee Company:** Located in the Hub, hours are seven days a week. (Monday-Thursday 0600-2400, Friday 0600-0100, Saturday 0800-0100, Sunday 0800-2400). Food and drinks are available, as well as free internet.

Subway, located inside the Gas Station, is open Monday through Thursday 1000-1930, Friday 1000-1900, and Saturday 1100-1900.

Information Resource Center

There is an Information Resource Center (IRC) available for all personnel. The IRC offers the following services:

- **Coast Guard Standard Workstation IIIs:** Available for homework or to catch up on work while away from the office.
- **IRC staff:** A valuable resource to answer your computer related questions.
- **Computer Tutorials:** Up-to-date CD-ROM or paper based tutorials on software applications.

The IRC is located on the 2nd deck of the Juliet Nichols Building (JNB), room 214. Hours are Monday through Friday from 0730-2000. Saturday hours is 1000-1600 and Sunday hours is 0900-1300 Sunday. Holiday hours are 0900-1300. Closed Christmas, New Years, Thanksgiving and the observed Coast Guard Day. The IRC staff can be reached at (707) 765-7523.

Post Office

The US Postal Service runs a full service Post Office on board the Training Center (Mace Building) from 1100-1400, Monday through Friday, except holidays. Financial

Health Care

TRACEN Petaluma Health Clinic

Medical Services are available to primarily active duty members. The availability of health care for non-active duty beneficiaries is very limited. All non-active duty beneficiaries are encouraged to utilize the TRICARE system to obtain health care services. To request a medical appointment contact (707) 765-7200.

Note: “Active Duty Sick Call” is intended to address the health care needs of acutely ill active duty members. Active duty members are required to make appointments for non-acute care needs.

Medical hours of operation are:

- Active Duty Sick Call Morning 0700-0800
- Appointments Call for availability
- **Friday Afternoons** **Closed for training**

Dental Services: are available to active duty members only.

Dental hours of operation are:

- Active Duty Sick Call 0700-0800
- Appointments Call for availability
- **Friday Afternoons** **Closed for training**

After Hours Care

The clinic is manned after hours to provide **Urgent** health care to **active duty members only**. Contact (707) 765-7200 or report to the clinic Urgent Care Entrance.

Health Care, *Continued*

Pharmacy Services

The clinic pharmacy can fill prescriptions for medications, included on the clinic formulary, for all authorized beneficiaries. The clinic offers an over-the-counter medication service. This service is available to all eligible beneficiaries.

The pharmacy hours of operation are:

Monday through Wednesday 0700-1030 and 1200-1430

Thursday through Friday 0700-1030

The pharmacy is closed on Thursday and Friday afternoons for training. The pharmacy can be reached at (707) 765-7194.

Medical Requirements and Health Records

Prior to departing from your command to attend training at Training Center Petaluma, please insure that your unit Yeoman has mailed your health record to the Training Center Petaluma Clinic.

Remember: It is imperative that we have your health record to prepare you for unrestricted worldwide assignment upon completion of your training.

Health services maintenance requirements for permanently assigned active duty members will be updated when you report, periodically during your stay and prior to your PCS departure.

For “A” School students, preparation to meet the requirements for sea duty and overseas duty will be initiated during your “A” school class indoctrination at the clinic.

Completion of your indoctrination requires your health record.

The clinic Health Benefits Office provides health benefits advice to all beneficiaries. The Health Benefits Office can be reached at (707) 765-7564.
