Subj: REQUEST FOR CRSP EARLY RETIREMENT

1. In accordance with references (a) and (b), I request retirement on the first day of (Month) 2013, instead of the default CRSP retirement date of 1 December 2013.
2. I understand if this is a voluntary retirement request and it is approved, I will no longer be eligible for advancement and servicewide competition, or my name will be removed from present eligibility lists, as appropriate.
3. I understand that only members selected for involuntary retirement who elect to remain involuntarily retired will remain on the eligibility list and may advance up to the day prior to retirement. In accordance with article 3.A.13.f of reference (c), an approved voluntary retirement immediately removes a member from the enlisted advancement eligibility list.
4. I further understand that if I am being processed under the Physical Disability Evaluation System, my selection for Involuntary Retirement will be held in abeyance pending the adjudication of my medical board.

The 2012 Career Retention Screening Panel has selected you for involuntary retirement, which will result in a separation program designator (SPD) code of LBD on your DD-214 indication sufficient service for retirement, involuntary retirement. If you do not make a selection below, the default code will be LBD.
