Learning Outcomes: Upon completion of the course, the student will be able to demonstrate procedures in the event of environmental threat from nuclear, radiological, biological, and chemical attacks; demonstrate safety procedures on land and entry points; demonstrate navigation techniques and skills using terrain maps; identify procedures for searches and security; execute proper movement and patrolling techniques; and explain basic maritime law enforcement safety procedures.

Instruction: Audiovisual materials, practical exercises, discussion, case studies, learner presentations, classroom exercises, laboratory, and lecture. Topics include knowledge of maritime law, and nuclear, biological, radiological and chemical threats.

Credit Recommendation: In the lower-division baccalaureate/associate degree category, 1 semester hour in military science (marksmanship); and 3 in homeland security, or in ordnance disposal, or port and maritime security, or 3 in hazardous materials (nuclear, biological, radiological and chemical (NRBC)) (1/07)(1/07).
