Incident 1:

(Home Port - Marietta, OH) On 26 May 2012 at 0037 UTC the COSPAS-SARSAT system detected a 406 MHz PLB at 37 32.48N 110 38.30W, in Glen Canyon National Recreation Area, UT. A solo kayaker near Bullfrog Bay was in distress and activated his beacon. Air Force Rescue Coordination Center (AFRCC) received the alert and contacted Glen Canyon National Park Services. AFRCC relayed SARSAT information to Glen Canyon National Park Services to locate the kayaker. The Glen Canyon National Park Services launched boats to rescue the kayaker. The kayaker experienced hypothermia and was transported to Bullfrog clinic for further treatment.
