

CSNCOE FIELD NOTICE #04-2011

Subject: Cruise Vessel Security & Safety Act (CVSSA) of 2010

For: US Coast Guard Foreign Passenger Vessel Examiners/OCMI Reps

On July 22, 2011 CSNCOE NOTICE #3-2011 was sent to the field providing a reference to CG-543 Policy Letter 11-09. It was stated in the notification that a MISLE “drop-down” box would be established to input deficiencies found in the field related to CVSSA. However we have been informed that the MISLE enhancement request will be made sometime in the future. For now, as a temporary arrangement, the CSNCOE recommends that the following statement is added to your MISLE Narrative- the vessel was checked for compliance with the CVSSA and the following items were noted (if any); in addition, until a CVSSA drop down category is available you should enter CVSSA data under System - “Operations Management”, Sub-System – “Security”, for Component select “Security Measures- Access Control”. In the details section, type in the acronym CVSSA and then enter details of deficiency. Please note, this is a temporary measure until the CSNCOE’s request for a CVSSA MISLE dropdown enhancement has been completed.
