Mr. Reinert is the Regional Desk Manager for Southeastern Europe and Middle Eastern nations, including those in the CENTCOM Area of Responsibility (AOR). He has oversight responsibilities for all U.S.C.G. Deepwater Program International Security Assistance (SA) and Foreign Military Sales (FMS) activities in the CENTCOM AOR. In addition, Mr. Reinert coordinates all relevant events that involve the Deepwater Program as they pertain to cooperative initiatives in the region. The Deepwater Program is the largest acquisition program in the history of the Coast Guard. This innovative acquisition program will develop, acquire, and sustain an affordable integrated system of surface, air, command and control, and logistics assets that serve America's maritime and security requirements.



Mr. Reinert has been involved with U.S. Government international security cooperation programs both in the U.S. and abroad for over 6 years. He is very knowledgeable of FMS, Armaments Cooperative Projects (ACP), and Direct Commercial Contracts (DCC) procedures. His final Navy tour was as a Country Program Director at the Navy International Programs Office in Washington, DC, after which he retired at the rank of Commander, USN.
