Subj: COAST GUARD SPECIAL PERMIT 7-92R

Dear Ms. Flowers:

Enclosed is Special Permit 7-92R authorizing American Alloys, Inc. to transport ferrosilicon in bulk by unmanned covered barge.

The enclosed permit has been revised to be consistent with other recently-issued Special Permits. In Section 9, paragraphs (b), (c), (g) and (h) are new special transportation requirements that did not appear in your previous permits. Also, former paragraphs (a)(1), (b)(1) and (b)(2) have been redesignated (a), (j) and (l) and have been amended. Because of the addition of new provisions, former paragraphs (a)(2), (a)(3), (a)(4) and (a)(5) of your previous permit are now designated, respectively, (e), (f), (i) and (d); and former paragraphs (b)(3), (b)(4), (b)(5) and (b)(6) are now paragraphs (k), (m), (n) and (o).

The enclosed permit is issued for a term of four years and will expire on January 31, 2001.
