**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON OIL POLLUTION PREPAREDNESS,  
RESPONSE AND CO-OPERATION, 1990**

**Accession by Tunisia**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Co-operation, 1990, and to state that, in accordance with article 15 accession by the Republic of Tunisia was effected by deposit of an instrument on 23 October 1995.

The Convention will enter into force for Tunisia on 23 January 1996, in accordance with the provisions of article 16.

There are, at present, twenty-six Contracting States to the Convention.
