OPTIONAL ANNEX V

Application to the Falkland Islands (Malvinas)¹

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to state that he received, on 14 November 1995, a notification from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland that Optional Annex V of the International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships, done at London on 2 November 1973, as modified by the Protocol relating to the said Convention, done at London on 17 February 1978, shall apply in respect of the Falkland Islands with immediate effect.
