**AMENDMENTS TO RESOLUTION A.706(17) -
WORLD-WIDE NAVIGATIONAL WARNING SERVICE**

The Maritime Safety Committee, at its sixty-sixth session (28 May to 6 June 1996), adopted the annexed amendments to resolution A.706(17) - World-Wide Navigational Warning Service, in accordance with the amendment procedure prescribed in annex 2 thereto, and decided they should enter into force on 1 January 1998.

ANNEX

AMENDMENTS TO RESOLUTION A.706(17) -
WORLD-WIDE NAVIGATIONAL WARNING SERVICE

"To remind NAVAREA and national Co-ordinators of the absolute necessity to monitor their broadcasts on SafetyNET and NAVTEX in order to provide the most efficient and effective services to mariners and reduce their own costs to a minimum, it is proposed to amend Annex 1 of resolution .706(17) as follows:

- to add new paragraph 6.2.1.15:

".15 monitor the broadcasts which they originate to ensure that the messages have been correctly broadcast";

- to add new paragraph 6.2.1.16:

".16 co-ordinate preliminary discussions between Member States seeking to establish NAVTEX services and neighbouring administrations, prior to formal application"; and

- to add new paragraph 6.6.1.13:

".13 monitor the broadcasts which they originate to ensure that the messages have been correctly broadcast"."
