INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON MARITIME SEARCH AND RESCUE, 1979

Accession by Georgia and the Republic of Korea

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Maritime Search and Rescue, 1979, and to state that accession by the Republic of Georgia and the Republic of Korea was effected by the deposit of instruments on 25 August and 4 September 1995, respectively, in accordance with article IV.

The Convention will enter into force for Georgia and for the Republic of Korea on 24 September and 4 October 1995, respectively, in accordance with the provisions of article V.

There are, at present, fifty-three Contracting States to the Convention.
