**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON TONNAGE  
MEASUREMENT OF SHIPS, 1969**

**Accession by Ecuador and Jordan**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, done at London on 23 June 1969, and to state that, in accordance with article 16 of the Convention, accession by the Republic of Ecuador and the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan was effected by deposit of instruments on 21 September and 3 October 1995, respectively.

The Convention will enter into force for Ecuador and Jordan on 21 December 1995 and 3 January 1996, respectively, in accordance with the provisions of article 17.

There are, at present, one hundred and eleven Contracting States to the Convention.
