**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON CIVIL LIABILITY FOR  
OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE**

**Accession by Mauritania**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, 1969, and to state that accession by the Islamic Republic of Mauritania was effected by deposit of an instrument on 17 November 1995, in accordance with article XIII.

The Convention will enter into force for Mauritania on 15 February 1996, in accordance with the provisions of article XV of the Convention.

There are, at present, ninety-two Contracting States to the Convention.
