

Marinette, Wisconsin TSI/PREP Exercise Scenario
Draft 7 June 2004

September 21, 2004 - The U. S. Coast Guard Ninth District Command Center receives an intelligence report from a reliable source that the foreign-flagged freight vessel VIKING I has a bomb on board, which will be detonated when the vessel transits a high traffic area.

September 22, 2004 – The VIKING I is en route to Marinette, WI. The Captain of the Port (Marine Safety Office Milwaukee) orders the vessel to anchor offshore Marinette, Wisconsin at position 45 degrees 05' 36" North latitude, 087 degrees 33' 54" West longitude in Wisconsin waters.
