Subj: INDEFINITE REENLISTMENT PROGRAM

Introduction This E-Mail ALPERSRU provides an update to policies and procedures previously outlined in reference (a).

Clarification of and Changes to Policies and Procedures The Indefinite Reenlistment Program applies to **all** active duty enlisted personnel who have 10 or more years of active service. [Reference (a) indicated E-5 and above.]

The Indefinite Reenlistment Program **only** applies to members of the Regular Coast Guard. Members of the Coast Guard Reserve may not reenlist for an indefinite period of time. They must reenlist for a period of 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 8 years, as prescribed in Article 1.G.2.c. of reference (b).

Indefinite Reenlistments are for an indefinite period up to the **last day of the month** in which a member reaches their 30-year active duty anniversary date. [Reference (a) indicated expiration of enlistment date would be set to the member's 30-year anniversary date (minus 1 day). Reference (b) will be updated by COMDT (G-WPM) to reflect this new policy.]

If a member is authorized by CGPC to serve on active duty beyond their 30-year anniversary date (last day of that month), e.g., Gold Badge Master Chiefs, **do not** submit an Indefinite Reenlistment transaction in SDA II. Send an e-mail to hrsic-mas@hrsic.uscg.mil requesting that HRSIC (MAS) take appropriate action to adjust the member's expected active duty termination date.
