COMMANDANT INSTRUCTION M1427.2AC

Subj: REGISTER OF RESERVE OFFICERS

Ref: (a) 10 U.S. Code, Section 14002 (b) 14 U.S. Code, Section 725

- 1. PURPOSE. In accordance with references (a) and (b), this Manual promulgates, by precedence, the list of officers of the Coast Guard Reserve in an active status. It also includes listings of Reserve officers in an inactive or retired status.
2. ACTION. Area, district and sector commanders, commanders of maintenance and logistics commands, Commander Deployable Operations Group, commanding officers of headquarters units, deputy/assistant commandants for directorates, Judge Advocate General and special staff offices at Headquarters shall ensure that the provisions of this manual are followed and notify all reserve commissioned and warrant officers that this Manual is published on the internet. Internet release is authorized.
3. DIRECTIVES AFFECTED. Register of Reserve Officers, COMDTINST M1427.2AB, is cancelled.
4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF INFORMATION. The information contained in this Manual reflects the status of the officer corps on 1 January 2009. For corrections to the Register of Reserve Officers, submit a Correction of Register of Officers Form (CG-5001), which is available on Adobe Forms. Form CG-5001 may be mailed or faxed to Coast Guard Personnel Service Center, Reserve Personnel Management Division.
5. AVAILABILITY. An electronic version will be located on the http://www.uscg.mil/directives and CGCENTRAL (Once in CG Central, click on the "RESOURCES" Tab and then "DIRECTIVES"). Paper copies will not be distributed.
6. ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECT AND IMPACT CONSIDERATIONS. Environmental considerations were examined in the development of this Manual and have been determined to be not applicable.
