Notice of Availability: The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) is providing funding assistance toward the Army Corp of Engineer's proposed beach re-nourishment project at the Coast Guard's Training Center in Cape May, NJ. A copy of the ACOE's Environmental Assessment (EA) which has been adopted by the Coast Guard and a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Coast Guard elements of the project is available at the Cape May County Library located at 30 Mechanics Street, Cape May Court House, NJ 08210. The USCG's decision to proceed with the final funding for the ACOE's proposed re-nourishment project will take effect 30 days following the publication of this notice.
