SORTS is the principal operational reporting system used by the U. S. Armed Services.

SORTS is the only reporting system that systematically assesses unit operational readiness to conduct both the Coast Guard and Naval Warfare missions based on assigned resources and training levels.

The SORTS Decision Aid helps Cutter crews produce accurate and properly formatted SORTS messages and automatically provides input to the Force Readiness Command's unit Readiness Dashboard.

Bottom Line: Readiness reporting made easy.
