CONFIDENCE's primary missions include maritime law enforcement and search & rescue. Due to the recent increase in the number of Cuban and Haitian migrants, CONFIDENCE is most often tasked to conduct interdiction patrols; you may witness a large number of migrants being detained on deck.

USCGC CONFIDENCE (WMEC 619) is the fifth of the Coast Guard's RELIANCE class medium endurance cutters. The CONFIDENCE was commissioned on February 19, 1966 at the United States Coast Guard Yard in Curtis Bay, Maryland. She was designed for search and rescue, law enforcement, and alien migrant interdiction operations (AMIO). From 1966 to 1983, CONFIDENCE was home ported in Kodiak, Alaska. In the spring of 1983, after seventeen years in Alaska CONFIDENCE was reassigned to Port Angeles, Washington. In 1987 CONFIDENCE was decommissioned to undergo an 18 month Major Maintenance Availability at the Coast Guard Yard. In October 1988 she was again commissioned and proudly rejoined the active fleet at her new homeport of Port Canaveral, Florida.

CONFIDENCE's awards include the Coast Guard Unit Commendation (6), Coast Guard Meritorious Unit Commendation (5), National Defense Service Medal (3), Humanitarian Service Medal (4), Coast Guard Special Operations Ribbon (4), and the Coast Guard "E" Ribbon (10). In her 46<sup>th</sup> year of service to the nation, CONFIDENCE remains Semper Paratus, performing with unparalleled success in a wide range of Coast Guard missions. Firmly rooted in her history of accomplishments, CONFIDENCE will continue to live up to her motto, "*Mensura Excellentiae...MEASURE OF EXCELLENCE.*"
