Commander Jordan's other afloat assignments include tours as Navigator and Damage Control Assistant aboard USCGC EAGLE (WIX 327), as Executive Officer on USCGC SWEETGUM (WLB 309) in Mobile, AL and most recently as Executive Officer onboard the 270 foot Medium Endurance Cutter TAMPA (WMEC 902), homeported in Portsmouth, Virginia.

Assignments ashore include tours as Assistant Operations Officer at the National Strike Force Coordination Center in Elizabeth City, NC; Resources Branch Chief for the Intelligence Division Coast Guard Atlantic Area in Portsmouth, VA; Resources Branch Chief and plankowner of the Maritime Intelligence Fusion Center Atlantic (MIFC-LANT) in Virginia Beach, VA and Resources Branch Chief in the Electronic Systems Division at the Maintenance and Logistics Command Atlantic (MLCLANT) in Norfolk, VA.
