Lieutenant Commander Newton assumed duties as Executive Officer of CGC DILIGENCE on 18 July 2008. He began his Coast Guard career in 1995 as an Engineer Officer in Training and Damage Control Assistant aboard the Coast Guard Cutter LEGARE. From 1999 to 2002, he was stationed at Naval Engineering Support Unit Boston. He served one year as Area Cutter Section Chief and Port Engineer for six Medium Endurance Cutters and CGC EAGLE; and two years as the Search and Rescue and Patrol Boat Section Chief. In the summer of 2002 he returned to sea for a three year tour as Engineer Officer onboard Coast Guard Cutter THETIS.

In 2005, Lieutenant Commander Newton assumed duties as Coast Guard Military Aide to the Vice President. During his three years as Military Aide, he planned and executed emergency response plans and accompanied the Vice President in forty-four states and fourteen countries throughout the world.

Lieutenant Commander Newton graduated from the Coast Guard Academy in 1995 with a Bachelors of Science in Mechanical Engineering. He earned a Master of Science in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering from the University of Michigan in 1999.
