Whether MOHAWK is your first tour afloat or you are an old sea dog, one of the most important pieces of information is “What are the living conditions like?” MOHAWK is considered “arduous sea duty”, but the living conditions are good. There are x berthing areas for enlisted members E-6 and below. In each berthing area, crewmembers are assigned two lockers; one stand-up locker and one locker contained in the space under your rack. Most racks are three high. Photographs of racks and lockers are included below.

In addition to berthing areas, crew members enjoy three separate TV/recreation lounges and a computer lab which has several computers that crewmembers can use to send and receive e-mail, work on on-line college courses, and to use for business purposes. There are also TVs located on the mess deck where movies are shown on three separate channels while underway. Satellite TV is also available when we're underway. Movies and satellite TV are available during non-working hours.
