THETIS and her crew have completed yet another successful patrol and everyone has collected a few sea stories. *THETIS* bagged the first of two drug busts on the patrol off the coast of Nicaragua shortly after reaching the operating area. Two weeks later, a second vessel carrying more than three times as much cocaine was captured off of Panama. In just a short month of patrolling, the crew of *THETIS* managed to prevent roughly 4400 pounds of cocaine from reaching American shores. Besides working hard catching drug smugglers, the crew also enjoyed port calls in Bocas del Toro, Panama and Miami, Florida before proceeding up to Mayport Naval Station to engage in three weeks of rigorous training in shipboard firefighting, navigation, search and rescue, and naval combat. Congratulations to ET2 Robert Mixon who advanced during the patrol!



CGC THETIS intercepted and stopped two vessels preventing over 4400 pounds of cocaine worth over \$60 Million from reaching the US.






CGC THETIS is moored up next to CGC ESCANABA while training at Naval Station Mayport in Jacksonville, FL.
