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## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (cont'd)

### E-Learning

- The **Civilian Orientation Online Course** is targeted for new employees at all grade levels but may be used by all for a reference or refresher. New employees are required to complete the training within the first 30 days of employment. The course takes approximately 5 hours to complete. It covers the Coast Guard's customs, courtesies, ranks/rates, missions, assets, units, organizational structure, history, personnel system, and more. Available at <https://learning.uscg.mil>
- **Free e-learning courses from SkillSoft.** The catalog includes leadership, management, personal development, communication, and many other topics. Available at <https://uscg.skillport.com> (once logged in, click on "Catalog," then "Business Skills Curricula").
- **Mentoring Online Course** (all grade levels). A self-paced, interactive course that covers a mentoring overview, mentoring skills, and tips for mentees. (Takes up to 3 hours to complete.)

### Individual Development Plan (IDP)

The IDP is a personally tailored action plan that the supervisor and individual use to identify short and long-term personal and career goals. It outlines the training and developmental experiences to achieve those goals.
