Master Chief Petty Officer Rodney J. Storle assumed duties as Command Master Chief, of Force Readiness Command (FORCECOM) in July 2015. As the senior enlisted advisor to the FORCECOM Commander, Master Chief Storle advises on workforce policies, is the senior enlisted mentor, and acts as the sounding board for select administrative actions and initiatives relative to the day to day operations of units throughout the United States and their impact on the work force.

Master Chief Storle also devotes much time traveling throughout the United States visiting units, meeting with the crews, observing training and communicating with Coast Guard personnel and their families.



Prior to being assigned as the FORCECOM Command Master Chief, Master Chief Storle served as Command Master Chief of the 17th Coast Guard District, headquartered in Juneau, Alaska.

Master Chief Storle has served in afloat assignments aboard the CGC SWEETBRIAR in Cordova, Alaska, the CGC ACTIVE in Port Angeles, Wash., CGC POINT BAKER in Sabine Pass, Texas, as Executive Petty Officer and CGC MELLON in Seattle. Master Chief Storle has also served at shore assignments including Station Gray's Harbor in Westport, Wash., Aids to Navigation Team Sabine Pass, Texas, as Executive Petty Officer, as Officer in Charge of Aids to Navigation Team St. Petersburg, Fla., and as the Assistant Chief of the Boat Forces Standardization Team in Yorktown, Va. He also served as Command Master Chief of Patrol Forces Southwest Asia, headquartered in Manama, Kingdom of Bahrain.

Master Chief Storle is a graduate of the Coast Guard Chief Petty Officers Academy class 101 and the Coast Guard Senior Enlisted Leadership Course, in addition to the National Defense University's Keystone Joint Senior Leadership School.

Master Chief Storle is the recipient of 48 medals and awards, which include three Meritorious Service Medals, Coast Guard Commendation Medals, Coast Guard Achievement Medals and the Commandant's Letter of Commendation. Additionally, he has been awarded the permanent Cutterman, Coxswain, Boat Forces (Advanced), Officer in Charge Ashore, Command Master Chief (silver) and Command Master Chief (gold) devices.
