SUBJ: ARMED LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SECURITY OCCUPATIONAL ANALYSIS SURVEY 1. IN OCTOBER 2007, I INITIATED PHASE II OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT, TACTICAL AND SECURITY GROUP OCCUPATION (LETSGO) STUDY. THIS EFFORT BUILDS UPON THE FINDINGS OF THE FIRST PHASE AND IS CURRENTLY ANALYZING THE TRAINING AND CAREER NEEDS OF ACTIVE DUTY AND RESERVE PERSONNEL WHO PERFORM ARMED LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SECURITY DUTIES.

2. WE ARE NOW ENTERING A KEY STAGE OF PHASE II. BEGINNING 22 JANUARY, THOUSANDS OF ENLISTED MEN AND WOMEN WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE ARMED LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SECURITY OCCUPATIONAL ANALYSIS SURVEY. THIS ON-LINE SURVEY WILL IDENTIFY THE COMMON SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE, AND EXPERIENCES THAT WILL INFORM DECISIONS REGARDING THE POSSIBLE CREATION OF A NEW RATING AND DEVELOPMENT OF OTHER HUMAN RESOURCE ACTIONS. ALL CG ACTIVE DUTY AND RESERVE ENLISTED PERSONNEL CURRENTLY PERFORMING ARMED LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SECURITY RELATED DUTIES, ALL DSF PERSONNEL, AND ALL RESERVE PORT SECURITY (PS) PERSONNEL WILL RECEIVE A DIRECT EMAIL, WITH AN EMBEDDED LINK, ASKING THEM TO COMPLETE THE SURVEY. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE AN EMAIL AND YOU FALL WITHIN ONE OF THESE CATEGORIES, YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE THE SURVEY BY GOING TO WWW.MTISURV.COM/LE PASSWORD FOR THE SURVEY IS ENFORCEMENT. THE SURVEY WILL BE AVAILABLE ON BOTH THE INTRANET AND INTERNET ALLOWING COMPLETION USING EITHER A CG OR HOME COMPUTER SYSTEM.

3. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE REGARDING THIS SURVEY, ESPECIALLY BETWEEN NOW AND THE DATE OF THE FIRST SURVEY DATA PULL ON 18 FEB 08. TIMELY COMPLETION OF THIS SURVEY IS ESSENTIAL TO THE SUCCESS OF THE LETSGO STUDY AND FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO OUR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SECURITY MISSIONS. THE LETSGO PHASE I REPORT OUTLINED WHY FUNDAMENTAL AND CONCRETE STEPS TOWARD ESTABLISHING LAW ENFORCEMENT, TACTICAL, AND SECURITY GROUP DUTIES AS AN OCCUPATION, COMPETENCY, OR SPECIALITY MUST BE TAKEN, AND WITH URGENCY.

4. TO EMPHASIZE URGENCY, I HAVE ASSIGNED A STRICT AND AGGRESSIVE PLAN OF ACTION AND MILESTONES (POAM) TO THE STUDY GROUP. ALTHOUGH THE SURVEY WILL OFFICIALLY CLOSE ON 14 MARCH, A WIDESPREAD FIELD RESPONSE TO THE SURVEY BY 18 FEB WILL SIGNIFICANTLY ASSIST THE STUDY TEAM IN PREPARING FOR THE ANALYTICAL PART OF PHASE II. 18 FEB IS A KEY WAY POINT AS IT WILL SHAPE OUR UNDERSTANDING OF DEMOGRAPHICS AND PROGRESS TOWARDS ACHIEVING FULL PARTICIPATION.

COMMANDING OFFICERS, OFFICERS IN CHARGE AND SUPERVISORS OF PERSONNEL IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH TWO SHOULD MAKE EVERY REASONABLE EFFORT TO ENABLE PERSONNEL TO EXPEDITIOUSLY COMPLETE THE SURVEY.

REACHING OUT TO RESERVISTS BETWEEN DRILL PERIODS TO NOTIFY THEM OF THE SURVEY AND ABILITY TO ACCESS FROM HOME IS ENCOURAGED.

5. THE AVERAGE SURVEY COMPLETION TIME IS 60-90 MINUTES. THE SURVEY CAN BE SAVED AND COMPLETED IN MULTIPLE SESSIONS. PARTICIPATION BY A MAJORITY OF ARMED LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL WILL BE A VALUABLE INVESTMENT IN THE FUTURE OF OUR ENLISTED WORK FORCE PERFORMING THESE IMPORTANT DUTIES. UNITS DEPLOYED DURING THE SURVEY PERIOD THAT EXPERIENCE DIFFICULTY ACCESSING THE SURVEY WILL BE PROVIDED A DEADLINE EXTENSION TO FACILITATE PARTICIPATION BY THEIR ENLISTED PERSONNEL.
