



YOU MAY NEED LEGAL ASSISTANCE IF...

- **YOU HAD PERSONAL PROPERTY (e.g., vehicle/clothing) LOCATED ON GOVERNMENT PROPERTY OR GOVERNMENT LEASED PROPERTY THAT HAS BEEN DAMAGED OR DESTROYED.**
- **YOU NEED ASSISTANCE IN FILING AN INSURANCE OR DISASTER ASSISTANCE CLAIM.**
- **YOU FILED A CLAIM WITH YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY AND HAVE A DISPUTE REGARDING POLICY TERMS.**
- **YOU NEED A POWER OF ATTORNEY.**
- **YOU NEED A WILL OR A "LIVING WILL" (advance medical directive).**
- **YOU HAVE A DISASTER RELIEF QUESTION AND NO ONE HAS BEEN ABLE TO GIVE YOU AN ANSWER.**

Disaster victims receive prioritized appointments. Coast Guard military personnel and their dependents living in California, Nevada, Utah and Arizona may contact the USCG legal assistance office at [510-437-5891](tel:510-437-5891) to receive initial advice and set up follow up appointments.
