

HYDRANT AND WATER MAIN FLUSHING

During the months of **July** and **August** the ISC Fire Department will be conducting annual fire hydrant flushing. This activity is necessary to remove sediment that has accumulated over time from water mains and to conduct hydrant/water system flow testing. During these activities, occupants and residents may experience short periods of discolored water. Although aesthetically unpleasant, the water is safe for use.

If you experience discolored water, you should turn on the cold water throughout your facility/residence (e.g. sinks, showers/bath tubs) until the water runs clear. Aerators should be removed from faucets, if practical, during this process to avoid blockage. With the aerator removed, take this opportunity to clean and remove the sediment that has accumulated in the aerator over time. Soaking the aerator in vinegar will help with this process.

The schedule of activity is as follows:

- The month of July / August - Upper Nymans Peninsula
- The month of July / August - Industrial/Commercial Areas (hangars, etc)
- The week of August 4 - August 9 - Aviation Hill Housing Complex
- The week of August 11 - August 16 - Upper Government Hill Housing Complex
- The week of August 18 - August 23 - Lower Government Hill Housing Complex
- The week of August 25 - August 30 - Lake Louise Housing Complex

Building 20 Rehab (Hangar II): Various contractors will perform a variety of work in the building over the next several years. The overall result will move the BOSS contractor out of some of their current spaces and into Building 20. This summer, the clerestory panels on the East side of the building are being replaced. Separate updates will be provided to affected individuals/organizations.

Housing Projects:

Lake Louise: Work at addresses 8000 thru 8018 Lake Louise Drive (Buildings 812 to 817) continues. Work includes fences, site grading/ditching, new above ground fuel tanks, and other building work. The rear yards of these units will be reworked in a similar fashion to last year's project on adjacent units. Project will continue through mid-August.

Townhouse Radon Remediation: Radon mitigation is underway in Housing Units SS, Y and Z. Work will be complete by early August.

Gingerbread Houses: Underground storage tanks for home heating fuel will be removed, and new above ground storage tanks will be installed. The installation of the above ground storage tanks will involve pouring a concrete slab in front of the boiler rooms. Once the tank has been installed, a 6ft privacy fence will be installed around the perimeter of the concrete slab. Residents will receive an updated plan within the week.

Upper Government Hill: The FAA will remove a tunnel which runs from the control tower to an escape building. This will impact the playground nearby playground during construction. Construction begins 11 August.

Paving/Civil/Demolition Projects:

AKDOT Sewer Line: A sewer and water project will run new utilities from the AKDOT facility across the highway to the Self-help building. This project will close Rezanof Drive and traffic will be re-routed onto Tom Stiles Road for several days in late July and early August.

Waterfront Paving: Paving and other site work will occur around the Cutter Storage building beginning in late July. Parking and storage in and around the area will need to be temporarily displaced during construction.

Demolish Building 554 (Old Work Life Building) and Demolish Building 12B (Steam Plant annex): Demolition will begin late August and run through September.

Fuel Pier Rehab Project: The Fuel pier is undergoing a major rehab. The pier will be out of commission 15 June to 15 November.

Firehouse Remodel: The fire house will undergo a major rehab to eliminate the squad bay berthing area and create smaller berthing modules. Construction will run August through October.

Building 26 Elevator Replacement: The passenger elevator will be replaced.

Construction will begin and passenger elevator will be out of service from July 8 to approximately August 5.

Bunker 124 Rehab: The bunker will be excavated, repaired and security fencing installed. Expect construction is underway and will be complete by September.

Steam Plant Chemical Feed System: The steam plant will receive mechanical upgrades for several systems.

Cargo Wharf (South End) Electrical Upgrade: The electrical shore tie system on the South end of the Cargo wharf will be rewired. Expect work to begin in July, with extended outages needed.

Cargo Pier Pile Repair: The Cargo Pier received damage during this winters storm. Several damaged piles will be replace/repaired. Schedule TBD.

Replace Air Station Fuel Stand Canopy: The fuel canopy for the Air Station refueling canopy will be replaced. Schedule TBD.

Energy Savings Performance Contract Project (ESPC): There are several projects happening around the base and housing for energy savings upgrades. These upgrades will vary from building. The majority of facilities upgraded will involve water efficiency upgrades, boiler and steam upgrades, ventilation cleanings and upgrades, and lighting upgrades. As much as possible, work for each building is scheduled concurrently to minimize the impact of tenants and residents. The schedule is fluid due to operational and planning requirements.

ESPC – DECCA Cold Storage Building Upgrade: The cold storage units in Building 27 will receive an efficiency upgrade. Work is underway and will continue through the summer.

ESPC – New Compressor in Building 26 (Exchange): Building 26 will receive compressor upgrades to the refrigeration system.

ESPC – Galley Air Handling Unit and Hoods Replacement: The galley will receive new hoods in the kitchen area and a new air handling unit for the building. This will cause the galley to be relocated to the Golden Anchor. The Galley is also receiving new refrigeration units under a separate concurrent contract.

ESPC – Connect Administration Building and Clinic to Steam System: The Clinic and the Administration Building will be connected to the steam building.

There are always new projects working their way through the pipeline. As the schedule and impact of these projects become known, information will be provided through future Backyard notices.
