Vessel Inspection Fees Notice of Inquiry Published

The U.S. Coast Guard today announced the Federal Register publication of a notice of inquiry seeking comments on proposed updates to annual vessel inspection fees. The updates would affect U.S. commercial vessels required to maintain a U.S. Coast Guard Certificate of Inspection and commercial foreign vessels, including tankships and mobile offshore drilling units, required to have a Certificate of Compliance.

Through this notice, the U.S. Coast Guard seeks public comment while considering options for updating and/or restructuring 46 CFR 2.10's inspection fee structure to ensure adequacy, equity, and to adapt to changes that have occurred since they were last modified in 1998.
