Using the Tampa Bay Digital Area Contingency Plan

The Tampa Bay Area Committee, chaired by the Captain of the Port, will conduct training on how to use the Tampa Bay Digital Area Contingency Plan (ACP). The ACP outlines strategies for a coordinated response to a discharge of oil or a release of a hazardous substance that could potentially impact environmental resources. By law, some companies are required to conform with ACP's and should utilize the plan during routine and annual response exercises.

Training will be held November 23, 2004 from 1 p.m. until 3 p.m. at the Tampa Port Authority Building, 1101 Channelside Drive, Tampa, FL 33602.
