

Update to the Opening of Monitoring Unit Guam: May 29, 2015

The National Maritime Center (NMC) announced earlier this month that the Monitoring Unit in Guam would be open to the public on June 1, 2015. Unfortunately, technical and IT issues have delayed the opening. We are working to resolve the issues as soon as possible, and will provide a future announcement with a new opening day.
