<p>Mariners holding valid Tankerman-PIC LG, Tankerman-PIC (Barge) LG, or Tankerman-Engineer endorsements may be issued STCW endorsements for Advanced Oil OR Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations, as appropriate, without having to meet additional requirements.</p> <p>Mariners holding a national endorsement as Tankerman-PIC (Barge) LG will be limited to non-self-propelled vessels.</p> <p>Mariners holding a national endorsement as Tankerman-Engineer will be limited to maintenance and repair of cargo equipment.</p>	13.607 NVIC 02-14	
Grandfathering – Service or Training prior to March 24, 2014		
<p>For national endorsements as Tankerman-PIC LG, Tankerman-PIC (Barge) LG, or Tankerman-Engineer may be issued STCW endorsements for Advanced Oil AND Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations without having to meet additional requirements until December 31, 2016.</p> <p>Mariners holding national endorsements as Tankerman-PIC (Barge) LG or Tankerman-Engineer will be limited same as above.</p>	NVIC 02-14
